



<p><b>FNDP sector priorities:</b> The FNDP affords extensive attention to governance priorities of a sub-national, national and supra-national character. It takes the bold step of treating many governance issues as 'crosscutting', insofar as performance in governance will affect the quality of results in all sectors. UNDP support corresponds to policy and reform priorities, as well as the programmes, objectives and strategies set out in Chapters 25, 26, 28 and 31 of the FNDP. Additionally, the FNDP contains an institutional framework for FNDP implementation, monitoring and evaluation in Chapter 38. UNDP will support the Ministry of Finance and National Planning in developing its institutional capacity to oversee Plan implementation, especially as this relates to the pursuit of the national development targets related to the Millennium Development Goals</p> <p><b>Role under the JASZ:</b> UNDP has a prominent role in support to national priorities in governance. Together with DfID and Norway, UNDP will provide support to the facilitation of overall governance dialogue between Government and cooperating partners. UNDP is a lead partner in support to constitutional, parliamentary and electoral reform, and an active partner in access to justice and human rights.
